Here is the most common ending and response in our parish:

English:

Leader: Lord Hear Us

Response: Lord Hear Our Prayer •

N.B. The word 'Prayer' in our response is always singular.

Te Reo Māori:

Leader: E te Ariki (translates as: O Lord)

Response: Whakarongo mai rā ki a mātou

(translates as: Listen to us)
